# THE LIBRARY

The exciting architecture of the building is noticeable especially in the library. An open space in three floors, built to let thoughts and ideas in. A room with a view, in fact the best view in town!

You borrow your books by yourself in our issuing devices – and we get more time to answer your questions. The books are partially located according to themes in order to find them more easily. Older books you can look for by yourself in our open storage. Through our home page, [www.lulea.se/bibliotek](http://www.lulea.se/bibliotek), you can borrow e-books, e-audio books and use more e-services.

The library has 24 Internet computers for the visitors. The computers are equipped with standard programs for the Internet, for word processing, calculus etc. You have access to services like genealogical research, full text databases for the press and much more.

## There are four places for questions and service:

At floor 3 (entrance floor) there is a counter for lending questions, letting of films, fees etc. Here you also have the counter of the children's library. There are information counters at floor 4 as well as at floor 5 (on the first respectively second floor). In the library you will find more than 200 000 books, newspapers, journals, films, music, audio books and cassette books.

## The entrance floor

On the entrance floor you borrow and return books. There is a counter for lending questions, questions concerning letting of films etc. Newspapers, discs and films are located here. You also find the children's library here.

## The first floor

Factual department and journals. Many books are located according to themes: Natur (Nature), Kultur och teknik (Culture and technology), Människa och samhälle (Mankind and society), Språk och religion (Language and religion). Here you can also find the microfilm room, Internet computers and an information counter.

## The second floor

Novels, poetry and drama, books in other languages and journals. History of literature, biographies, music and music books, the department for young readers. Cassette books for persons with a reading handicap. If we don't have the right book we can download it and burn a compact disc for you if you are a cassette book borrower. Here too, we have computers with Internet.

## The library has wings

At the first and second floor, the wings of the library are located by the glass windows facing Norra hamn. The bookshelves can be rolled away and here writer's performances and other events take place.

# CONCERT

In the middle of Luleå there is an oasis for music and lovers of culture. On our stages we offer you everything from rock music, pop music and jazz over to classical music, dance and children's performances, something for every liking. Kulturenshus arranges a large number of our own concerts every year, and in addition to that the stages are let to external organizers, anything from local associations to production companies. Kulturenshus is the home stage for Norrbotten Big Band and Norrbottens Kammarorkester.

## The big concert hall

The big concert hall has room for up to 1000 persons. This hall is an acoustic room where the sound of the room can be changed depending on what the stage is used for. The stage can be extended for bigger ensembles and the lighting can vary from daylight to total darkness.

## The small concert hall

When the audience is sitting down, the small concert hall has a capacity of up to 308 persons. When the audience is standing it has a capacity of up to 450 persons. The strength of the small concert hall is the flexibility. It has a stage that can be extended, a stand that can be folded up and the possibility of total darkness. In contrast to the big concert hall, this hall is subdued in its acoustic design.

# CONFERENCE AND CONGRESS

Kulturens hus is a popular meeting place for conferences and congresses with a capacity of up to 1000 persons. We have 7 new and well-equipped conference rooms, each with a capacity of 2-80 persons.

## **Olga Bardh**

A large conference room with a view over Luleås north port and into the centre of Kulturens hus.

## **VIP-room**

Our most exclusive room with a magnificent view over Luleås north port.

## **Erik Lindegren/Stina Aronson**

Two conference rooms with a view over Luleås north port. Suitable for smaller groups.

## **Conference rooms 1-3 (K1-K3)**

Conference rooms of average size that are also suitable for music rehearsal rooms, since the walls are extra soundproof.

## **The big concert hall**

The largest assembly room in Luleå with a capacity of up to 1000 persons. The stage can be extended and the lighting can vary from daylight to total darkness.

## **The small concert hall**

A flexible hall with a stage that can be extended, a stand that can be folded up and the possibility of total darkness. When the audience is sitting down, the small concert hall has a capacity of up to 308 persons. When the audience is standing it has a capacity of up to 450 persons.

## **Equipment**

Conference rooms: overhead projector, projection screen, data projector/LCD screen and whiteboard. Lilla and stora salen: overhead projector, data projector, DVD, projection screen, hi-fi system (including two wireless microphones), rostrum (including one wired microphone) and existing fixed light. In the hire of a room a technician is included.

# THE ART GALLERY

The exhibition area is about 500 m<sup>2</sup> divided into three exhibition halls and a long and narrow gallery. The gallery mentioned, where one of the walls is slightly arched, ties the halls together. From the gallery, which is located 1,5 metres higher than the exhibition halls, you reach the remotest halls by steps and lifts. From the gallery level you also receive a nice survey over the art gallery in whole and a beautiful view over Luleå north port and Norrbottensteatern in the background.

## **Exhibition hall 1 – about 200m<sup>2</sup>**

The steps between the gallery and the exhibition hall also perform the functions of a natural space for gatherings and expositions. In the inlet towards the gallery, a sliding wall can be pulled across and thereby enhance the hanging possibilities.

## **Exhibition hall 2 – about 120m<sup>2</sup>**

With the large sliding doors opened you receive a nice connection between the halls. If you shut the sliding doors the hall can be darkened and thereby create perfect opportunities for video art, film etc.

## **Exhibition hall 3 – about 100m<sup>2</sup>**

A beautiful room, well suited for sculptures. All three of the exhibition halls have a ceiling height of 4,8 metres.

## **The gallery – about 80m<sup>2</sup>**

A usable and exciting room with its arched wall and the fine connection with the exhibition halls. The ceiling height is about 2,8 metres.

## **The studio**

In the studio, children, young people, adults, associations and groups from different places of work can work creatively with different materials and techniques under the guidance of an art pedagogue. Groups must be booked in advance.

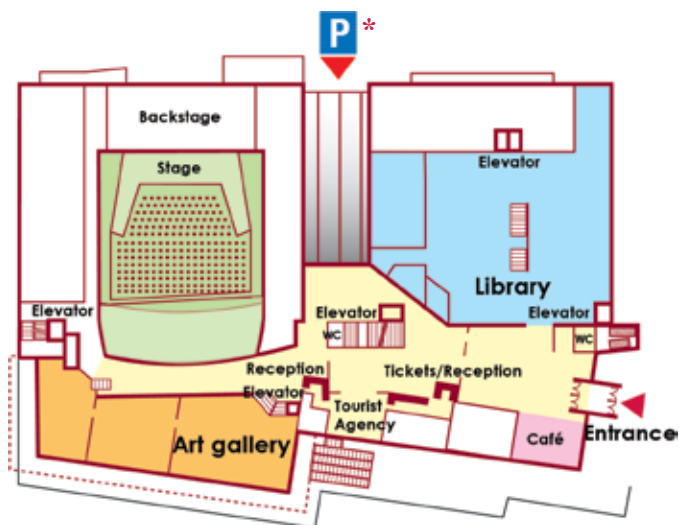

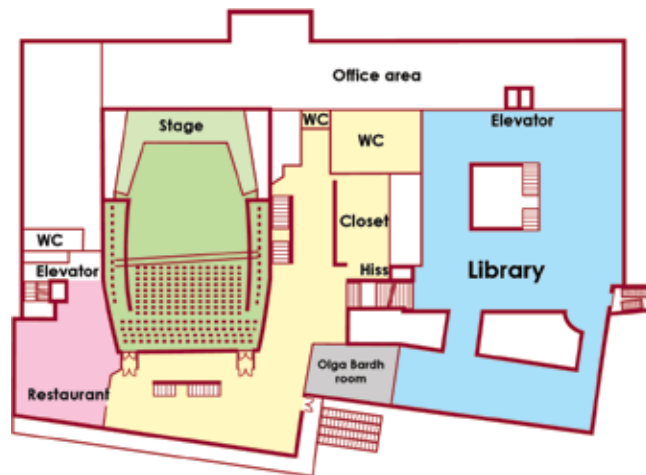

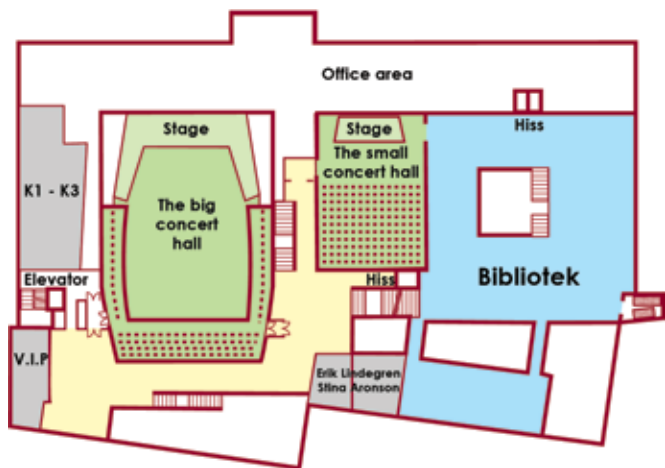
## FLOOR 3 - ENTRANCE FLOOR

You enter Kulturens hus from the south, i.e. the side that faces Skeppsbrogatan. At this floor you find the box-office/reception desk, café and the tourist agency. Further on you find the art gallery with its own reception desk. To the right just inside the entrance you find the ground floor of the library.



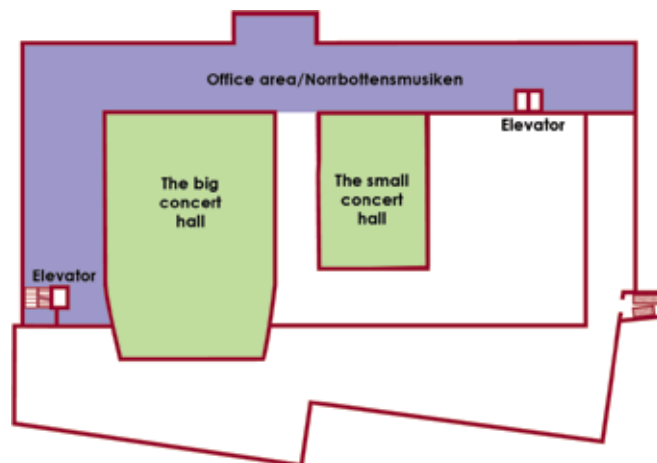
## FLOOR 4

Entrance to The big concert hall, cloakroom and lavatories. In the corner facing the roundabout you find the restaurant with a view over Luleås north port. Here you also find a conference room called Olga Bardh.



## FLOOR 5

At floor 5 you find The small concert hall and the entrances to the stand of The big concert hall. At this floor you find most of the conference rooms, the Erik Lindegren and Stina Aronson rooms, K1-K3 and V.I.P.-room. Next to the V.I.P.-room you also find the bar.



## FLOOR 6

At the top of the house, Norrbottensmusiken has premises both for administration and rehearsals. The roofs of both of the concert halls reach up to this floor.
